The **B.E.E. Book** is this three ring binder that I have prepared for each student to carry to and from school every day.

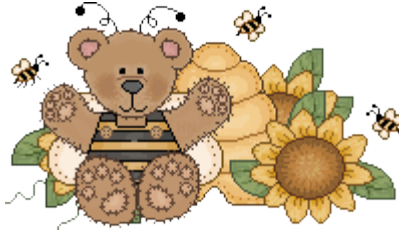
B.E.E is an acronym for **Bring Everything Everyday**

## B.E.E Book Rules

- 1 Take your B.E.E. Book home every day and bring it with you to school each morning.
- 2 Take good care of your B.E.E. Book. It will be used all year.
- 3 Use your B.E.E. Book for school only. Don't color or tear or make any marks on any of the pages.
- 4 Keep your B.E.E. Book clean. Do not eat or drink while using it.
- 5 Show your B.E.E. Book to your parents each day. They will be so proud that you are learning responsibility!
- 6 Put only papers that your teacher tells you to in your B.E.E. Book.
- 7 Keep your B.E.E. Book away from younger brothers or sisters and friends. Do not let anyone borrow, write, tear or draw pictures in it. Remember, it is yours!
- 8 Show your B.E.E. Book to your teacher every day. Remember, **you** are responsible for it.

## Here is what is inside the B.E.E. Book

<b>Important Papers from School</b> Inside-cover of binder	This section is for school notes and classroom notes that need to go home for parents.
<b>Zipper Pockets</b> Clear plastic pencil pockets	Here students store Word Wall cards, and Math Facts cards
<b>Homework and Behavioral Management</b> Red pocket folder	Homework will be sent home in this "HOMEWORK" folder and completed homework should be returned to school in the same folder. Please check this section daily. Parents also need to sign the homework sheet every day to indicate they checked that the homework is complete.
<b>My School Work to Keep at Home</b> Purple pocket folder	Here is where students put work to take home that stays at home.
<b>School/Classroom Information</b> Binder divider	Here is where you'll find things like the school calendar, class list, schedule, etc.
<b>Memory Verses</b> Binder divider	Here is where students collect their memory verses.
<b>Reading Log</b> Binder divider	Here is where students collect their <b>Reading Logs</b> and <b>Read At Home Charts</b>
<b>Spelling and Word Wall</b> Binder dividers	Spelling words list and Word Wall list will be collected here. Please do not remove list from the binder. They need to be here for unit tests review.
<b>Tests</b> Binder divider	Please check this section weekly to review tests. Please sign the tests to acknowledge that you have reviewed it with your child. Do not remove tests from the binder!
<b>Notes for Teacher</b> Inside pocket of the binder	This is the pocket for important notes like permission slips for field trips, excuse notes, etc. that need to go to teacher.
